Vector

File Format

AI, EPS, PDF, CDR, DWG/DXF

Color Mode

For best results, supply file in the original color mode in which it was created. Our in-house graphics team will handle any necessary color space conversions.

Size/Scale

Create your file at or in proportion to the actual size. If not, we will scale it for you and provide a shop drawing to approve size and placement.

Text

Convert all text to outlines.

Swatches

Remove unused colors and ensure all used colors are included for accuracy.

Preferred Layer Structure

GLASS: Include any pertinent dimensions

Side 1 Art: Artwork on side 1 of the glass, if applicable

Side 2 Art: Artwork on side 2 of the glass, if applicable

Additional layers as needed

TIFF, JPEG, PNG

Color Space

Resolution/File Size

Provide all raster images (photos, artwork, etc.) at the highest possible resolution.
